

Asynchronous Learning Days

- Asynchronous learning will take place when ICS is unable to have students in attendance due to inclement weather conditions.
- Asynchronous learning will only be used for no more than two (2) consecutive days. Any days following the two (2) days will be considered snow days. Snow days will need to be made up at the end of the year in accordance with the Illinois State Board of Education.
- Preschool and PreK teachers will provide supplemental materials to their students prior to asynchronous learning days.
- Grade K-4 teachers will provide curriculum assignments to their students prior to asynchronous learning days. Teachers will establish dates when curriculum assignments are due. Teachers will set up a virtual time to meet with students who are able to meet.
- Grade 5-8 teachers will provide curriculum assignments to their students prior to asynchronous learning days or through Google Classroom by 8:30 am on asynchronous days. Teachers will establish dates when curriculum assignments are due. Teachers will set up at least a three (3) hour time frame on each asynchronous day where they will be available for students for immediate replies to questions.
