KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS SOCCER CHALLENGE

On July 4th, at the City of Columbia Fireworks Celebration, the annual Knights of Columbus Soccer Challenge will be held from 4:00 to 5:30pm at the American Legion Park. The penalty kick skills competition is free and open to all kids through age 14 as of September 1st 2018. Of the 15 divisions, the first 3 are boys and girls together: up to age 6, age 7 and age 8, with winners not advancing. The other 12 divisions are ages 9 to 14 in which girls and boys compete separately and each winner earns the right to represent Columbia at the District Competition and perhaps the Regional and State Competitions. Participants are required to furnish proof of age and written parental consent. All divisions requiring a tiebreaker round will begin at 5:10pm. This is also an opportunity for individuals to earn community service time.
